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What is community engagement?

- Community: The condition of sharing or having certain attitudes and interests in common. a group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common.
- Q: Who are our stakeholders?
- Engagement: Establish a meaningful connection or contact with someone.
- . Q: What are we trying to achieve?

External:


Outcomes are out of your control.


Independent of hard work or effort

- The Joint Strategic Needs Assessment (JSNA) is a process by which lor and Clinical Commissioning Groups assess the current and future health wellbeing needs of the local community to inform local decision making.
- The JSNA:
- Characterises the health and wellbeing status of the local population
- Identifies inequalities
- Illustrates trends
- Describes local community views
- Highlights the key findings
