## Report on learning and development September 2020 – August 2021

#### Introduction

The Learning and Development (L&D) Working Group manages a devolved budget of £10,000 for learning and development activities across the District.

They met 4 times over Zoom to

- 1. Discuss and agree grant applications
- 2. Consider ways in which L&D opportunities could be promoted and continue to revise the database
- 3. Consider future activities

#### 1. Grants and activities
