Introduction to the District Payer Diary

Someone asked me recently "How will you ever have time in your day to pray for everyone in the Sheffield District?" The image that popped into my mind was of me working through a never-ending list of names and places, which would surely take days: circuits and churches, communities and projects, hopes and fears, joys and challenges.

But prayer is not simply working through a list. Prayer is attention, intention, relationship. When I open my emails, leaf through the District handbook, or read the newsletter, I find myself holding this wide-spread family of faith before God. That too is prayer.

We often imagine prayer as words, sentences formed, requests made, things asked of God. And sometimes it is exactly that. But prayer can also be as simple as turning a thought God-wards: pausing in the middle of a busy day, noticing a person or situation, lifting them silently to God and trusting that God hears the intentions of our hearts. Just as words are not always necessary in human relationships, they are not always necessary in our relationship with God.

So, whether we are watching the news with compassion, or walking through our daily tasks with awareness, prayer can infuse it all. This diary is a reminder of that: a gentle rhythm, guiding us to remember the many and varied people who make up our District. We are beautifully diverse, different contexts, different gifts, different callings, and yet united in the one God who holds us all.

May this prayer diary not be an addition to your daily tasks, but a companion: a reminder that to pray is simply to live with an open heart before God.
