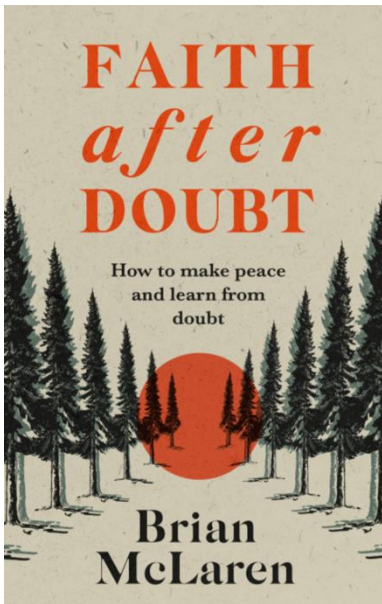


New book club for 2021 run by the District Learning and Development Group
