### MEMBERSHIP OF THE DISTRICT LEADING TEAM

#### **BACKGROUND**

In March 2021, following the launch of the district's new Mission Strategy and the completion of a governance review, a new constitution of the District Leading Team (DLT) was agreed. This moved away from a structure that included representatives from Circuits and established a way of being that we hoped would encourage more people from across the district to offer to serve on the DLT and use their gifts to help us move forward with the various strands of the Mission Strategy. Unfortunately, this has not proved to be the case and whilst we are grateful for those who have expressed an interest, we have still not been able to build the DLT that we had hoped.

## **CURRENT SITUATION**

It was therefore agreed at the November 2022 DLT meeting that a last push on recruitment should be attempted, but when by January 2023 that had not borne fruit, it was agreed that a proposed change to the constitution of the DLT should be brought to the March DLT meeting.

## **PROPOSAL**

The DLT discussed the matter and consulted the Superintendents' Meeting and the proposal set out below is now the recommended way forward.
