## Training

We have booked Jody to deliver the training over two days – **Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> June** – both days running from 10am-4pm - comprising of 6 sessions, which will consist of:-

- Sharing the story of the Unique Course how it all started, and the journey along the way
- Who should we aim the course at? What are the needs of the young people we work with?
- Helping you to personalise the course with your own experiences and stories What do you bring to the course
- Taking you through the Unique Course resources step by step, and practically leading some of the sessions and activities
- Looking at the practicalities of setting up a course in your area / school / youth provision
- Ongoing support and requirements

The training costs £200 per person. **The Circuit have secured a grant to cover the cost of the training for up to 15 participants.** The training will take part in Sheffield, with the exact venue TBC.

## License Agreement

The Unique Course Delivery License helps to ensure quality, excellent delivery and good practice across all the venues where the Unique Course is delivered, and protects the copyright of all of our materials.

The license states that only workers who are trained 'Unique Course' facilitators can lead the course or use any part of the materials. We appreciate that you may need to use a non-trained volunteer or member of staff to accompany you during a session, and we encourage all regular helpers to attend a training course as well. They will not be permitted to lead any course activity or lead a course themselves without having been trained and licensed.

You are licensed to deliver the Unique Course as a 10 week course with up to 10 young people. We ask that facilitators do not deliver one off sessions, or split the course up. Evaluation shows that the course works because it is a 10 week course, and each session builds on previous sessions. We ask that organisations and trained facilitators respect the ongoing work of the Unique Course in Sheffield, by not delivering courses in this area. If you do wish to deliver a course in Sheffield, we ask you to make contact Jody Wigfull-Coy to discuss this further.

We constantly work hard to ensure the high level of quality delivery and resources with each course, and we ask you not to lend, reproduce or copy any part of the Unique Course. Only team members from the Unique Course are allowed to deliver facilitator training of the Unique Course – so we ask that people do not train others in your organisation or other organisations.

We are unable to license anyone who is not part of, or affiliated with an organisation in some way. This is to ensure that child protection procedures and accountability processes are in place. Facilitators are licenced by the Unique Course, but are to work under their own organisations policies and procedures.
